Bloomberg Discrimination-Suit Ruling Renews Work-Life Debate (August 18)—For the many individuals who have debated endlessly how to find work-life balance, Judge Loretta A. Preska offered her blunt opinion in her ruling for Bloomberg L.P. in their discrimination case. “The law does not mandate ‘work-life balance,’ ” she wrote, in a decision issued on Wednesday. “In a company like Bloomberg, which explicitly makes all-out dedication its expectation, making a decision that preferences family over work comes with consequences.” In the sports world, does that opinion hold true for women aspiring to become athletic directors or commissioners?
